To accompany the petition of Daniel F. O'Brien for legislation relative to the retirement of State Police officers prior to January first, nineteen hundred and forty-eight. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF STATE POLICE OFFICERS PRIOR TO JANUARY FIRST, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FORTY-EIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special
2 law to the contrary, any state police officer who was
3 retired prior to January first, nineteen hundred and
4 forty-eight, shall receive a pension from the common-
5 wealth equal to two thirds of the compensation re-
6 ceived by him at the time of his retirement.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN THE SEVERAL COUNTIES OF PENNSYLVANIA.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight.

SECTION 1. That the following provisions of the act to amend an act to provide for the registration of voters in the several counties of Pennsylvania, passed at the second session of the Forty-third General Assembly, be and the same are hereby amended, so that the same shall read as follows, to-wit:
