

To accompany the petition of George W. McCarthy for legislation relative to the awarding of contracts by the University of Massachusetts and the University of Massachusetts Building Association and relative to the appointment of the director of said university by the Governor. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN CONTRACTS AWARDED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS BUILDING ASSOCIATION SHALL NOT BE AWARDED EXCEPT AFTER COMPETITIVE BIDDING THEREON, AND PROVIDING THAT THE DIRECTOR OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Every contract for the construction,
2 reconstruction, alteration, remodelling or repair of any
3 building by the University of Massachusetts and the
4 University of Massachusetts Building Association and
5 estimated to cost more than five hundred dollars shall
6 be awarded on the basis of competitive bids to the
7 lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

1 SECTION 2. All the directors of the University of
2 Massachusetts shall be appointed by the governor with
3 the advice and consent of the council.
