To accompany the petition of Joseph F. Gibney for legislation to allow the present water department of the town of Uxbridge to sell water for domestic and other purposes to inhabitants of a certain area. Water Supply.

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE PRESENT WATER DEPARTMENT OF
THE TOWN OF UXBRIDGE TO SELL WATER FOR DOMESTIC
AND OTHER PURPOSES TO INHABITANTS OF A CERTAIN
AREA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The town of Uxbridge may furnish and sell water
2 for domestic and other purposes to the inhabitants of
3 such areas of the town of Northbridge as the select-
4 men of the said towns shall agree. The rates for
5 furnishing and selling such water shall be such rates
6 as may be mutually agreed upon by said selectmen, or,
7 in case of failure to agree, as may be fixed by the state
8 department of public utilities. Any installation and
9 extension of water mains and other facilities made
10 within the limits of the town of Northbridge shall be
11 subject in all respects to the approval of the selectmen
12 of said town.
