To accompany the petition of Charles V. Hogan that Edward H. Charron of Lynn be compensated by the Commonwealth for sickness sustained by him while on duty as a member of the Massachusetts National Guard. Joint Ways and Means.

RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF EDWARD H. CHARRON OF LYNN.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a
2 moral obligation of the commonwealth and after an
3 appropriation therefor shall have been made, there
4 be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to
5 Edward H. Charron of Lynn the sum of
6 dollars on account of sickness sustained by him on
7 July seventeenth, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven,
8 while a member of the national guard on duty at
9 Camp Edwards. No payment shall be made here-
10 under until there has been filed with the comptroller
11 an agreement signed by said Edward H. Charron that
12 the amount, if any, paid or to be paid for legal services
13 rendered in connection with the passage of this resolve
14 shall not exceed ten per cent of the amount paid here-
15 under.
