AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY TO EXPEND MONEY FOR ADVERTISING THE RECREATIONAL, INDUSTRIAL AND AGRICULTURAL ADVANTAGES OF THE COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 106 of the acts of 1939 is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "recrea-
3 tional", in line 2, the words:—, industrial and
4 agricultural, — so that the first sentence will read as
5 follows:— The county commissioners of Franklin
6 county, for the purpose of advertising the recreational,
7 industrial and agricultural advantages of said county,
8 may expend such sums, not exceeding, in the aggre-
9 gate, five thousand dollars in any one year, as may be
10 appropriated therefor; provided, that such expendi-
11 tures from money so appropriated shall not at any
12 time be more than the sum which shall have been
13 contributed by public subscription or by donation
14 deposited with the county treasurer for the purpose
15 aforesaid.
