To accompany the petition of George W. Stanton, mayor, and the city council of the city of Fitchburg for legislation relative to the status of Raymond McGrath as a member of the fire department of said city. Civil Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STATUS OF RAYMOND McGRATH
AS A MEMBER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF
FITCHBURG.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Raymond McGrath, who served as a
2 military substitute in the fire department of the city
3 of Fitchburg from September, nineteen hundred and
4 forty-five to February, nineteen hundred and forty-
5 eight, and who was injured in the performance of
6 duty, shall be deemed to be permanently appointed
7 to the position of fireman in said fire department
8 without examination without being further required
9 to serve any probationary period; provided, that he
10 submits proof, satisfactory to the director of civil
11 service, that such injury does not incapacitate him
12 for the performance of the duties of fireman in said
13 fire department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
