

SENATE No. 751

To accompany the petition of Ralph V. Clampit that provision be made for the acquisition by the Commonwealth for armory purposes of a certain parcel of land in the city of Springfield. Military Affairs and Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION BY THE COMMONWEALTH FOR ARMORY PURPOSES OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subject to the approval of the governor and council
2 the armory commissioners are hereby authorized and
3 directed to acquire, for the purpose of increasing the
4 facilities of the state armory in the city of Springfield,
5 a parcel of land in said city now owned by Robert M.
6 Feldman *et ux* and described as follows:— Southerly
7 by West Union street sixty feet and five inches;
8 westerly by land formerly of Ellen L. Fisher, now,
9 as supposed, of Geo. S. Tapley, one hundred and
10 twenty-two feet and six inches; northerly by land
11 formerly of Lewis Warriner, now, as supposed, of his
12 heirs or devisees, sixty feet and six inches; and easterly
13 by land now or formerly of one Piper, one hundred and
14 twenty-two feet, said property being Nos. 78 to 82

15 West Union street, and being the same premises con-
16 veyed to said Robert M. Feldman *et ux* by deed of
17 Irving L. Ginsburg dated September fifteenth, nine-
18 teen hundred and forty-eight, and recorded in Hamp-
19 den county registry of deeds, book nineteen hundred
20 and fifty-eight, page five hundred and ten.

21 For said purposes the armory commissioners may
22 expend such sum not exceeding _____ as may
23 be appropriated therefor.
