## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF A SECTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY KNOWN AS ROUTE 140 IN THE TOWNS OF GRAFTON AND UPTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The state department of public works is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to lay out and reconstruct  
3 the state highway known as route one hundred and  
4 forty in the towns of Grafton and Upton. For the  
5 purposes of this act, said department may expend  
6 such sums as may be appropriated therefor from the  
7 Highway Fund.

To accompany the bill of the Senate of the State of New York, passed at the session of the Senate at Albany, on the 15th day of January, 1882, for the purpose of amending the laws relating to the State Highway Commission, and for other purposes.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF A ROAD OF THE STATE HIGHWAY KNOWN AS ROUTE 120 IN THE TOWNS OF HARTFORD AND STAMFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the State of Massachusetts, as follows:

1. The State Department of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to let out and reconstruct the State Highway known as route one hundred and twenty in the towns of Hartford and Stamford for the purpose of this act, said department may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor from the Highway Fund.
