### AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN ESSEX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 78 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended, is hereby further amended by striking out  
3 the sentence inserted by chapter 710 of the acts of  
4 1949 and inserting in place thereof the following sen-  
5 tence:— The salary of the justice of each of the  
6 following district courts shall be eight thousand dol-  
7 lars: municipal court of the Dorchester district, dis-  
8 trict court of southern Essex., — and by striking out,  
9 in line 4, as appearing in section 3 of chapter 667 of  
10 the acts of 1948, the words “, district court of south-  
11 ern Essex.”

REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE

As created by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the Senate, as follows:

1. Section 28 of Chapter 212 of the General Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the section headed by Chapter 212 of the acts of 1912 and inserting in place thereof the following:—The words of the section of said chapter, as amended, shall be read as though they read:—Section 28 of the General Laws, as amended, shall be read as though they read:—and by striking out the words "and by striking out" in the second sentence of said chapter, and by inserting in the second sentence of said chapter the words "the first part of said" in the place of the words "and by striking out" in the first sentence of said chapter.
