AN ACT RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM TAXATION
GRANTED SOLDIERS AND SAILORS AND THEIR WIVES,
WIDOWS, FATHERS OR MOTHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 534 of the acts of 1949 is hereby amended
- 2 by adding at the end the following section:—
- 3 *Section 3.* This act shall be applicable to taxes
- 4 levied in the year nineteen hundred and forty-nine,
- 5 upon application made not later than October first,
- 6 nineteen hundred and fifty.
