AN ACT EMPOWERING FARMERS TO RECOVER FARM HOUSING AT TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT OF OCCUPANT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 12 of chapter 239 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end the following
3 new paragraph: —

4 Nothing in this chapter shall prevent a farm owner
5 from recovering premises occupied for dwelling pur-
6 poses upon demand and legal termination of occupa-
7 tion when such premises are located on owner's farm
8 and the use or rental of such premises was in con-
9 sideration of continuing satisfactory employment on
10 owner's farm.
