AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REINSTATEMENT IN THE  
TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF HAROLD A. ROGERS,  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF RETIREMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Harold A. Rogers, a member of the teachers' re-  
2 tirement system for more than twenty years prior to  
3 December twelfth, nineteen hundred and forty-three,  
4 is hereby reinstated in the teachers' retirement sys-  
5 tem for the sole purpose of retirement for superannua-  
6 tion. Upon such reinstatement the teachers' retire-  
7 ment board shall retire said Harold A. Rogers with a  
8 retirement allowance based on his creditable service  
9 at his age, at the time of such retirement.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RETIREMENT OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES WHO HAVE SERVED FOR A CERTAIN NUMBER OF YEARS AND WHO ARE OVER A CERTAIN AGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN GENERAL COURT assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. There shall be a fund for the retirement of the members of the Senate and House of Representatives who have served for a certain number of years and who are over a certain age.
2. The fund shall be established by the appropriation of a certain amount of money from the State Treasury.
3. The fund shall be invested in the purchase of certain securities.
4. The fund shall be used for the payment of retirement allowances to the members of the Senate and House of Representatives who are entitled to such allowances.
5. The amount of the retirement allowance shall be determined by the number of years of service and the age of the member at the time of retirement.
6. The retirement allowance shall be payable to the member or to his estate.
7. The act shall take effect on the first day of January next following the date of its passage.
8. The act shall be subject to the approval of the Governor.
