

SENATE No. 335

To accompany the petition of George Emerson for legislation to grant certain increases in retirement allowances of less than twelve hundred dollars. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty.

AN ACT GRANTING CERTAIN INCREASES IN RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF LESS THAN TWELVE HUNDRED DOLLARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding,
2 standing, a person retired under the provisions of
3 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws with a re-
4 tirement allowance of less than twelve hundred dol-
5 lars, after not less than ten years of service, shall
6 have an increase in his retirement allowance of one
7 hundred dollars after attaining age seventy, and an
8 additional one hundred dollars every five years there-
9 after; but in any event the retirement allowance
10 under this act shall not be increased so as to exceed
11 twelve hundred dollars.

To increase the portion of foreign income for inclusion to
 that portion included in retirement allowances of less than twelve
 months' service (including the last day of service)

AN ACT DEPARTING CERTAIN PROVISIONS IN RELATION TO
 ALLOWANCE OF LESS THAN TWELVE MONTHS' SER-
 VICE.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
 in Town Court assembled, and by the majority of the
 same as follows:

1. The provision of law to the contrary notwith-
 standing, a person retired under the provisions of
 2 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws with a re-
 3 tirement allowance of less than twelve months' ser-
 4 vice, after not less than ten years of service, shall
 5 have an increase in his retirement allowance of one
 6 hundred dollars after attaining age seventy, and an
 7 additional one hundred dollars every five years there-
 8 after; but in any event the retirement allowance
 9 under this act shall not be increased so as to exceed
 10 twelve hundred dollars.
