### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF RUTH E. WEAVER OF SPRINGFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Ruth E. Weaver of Springfield, who has served the  
2 commonwealth since March, nineteen hundred and  
3 forty, as a member of the board of registration of  
4 hairdressers, shall, on retirement, be entitled to be  
5 come a member of the state retirement system by  
6 depositing in the annuity savings fund of said system  
7 the sum of                    dollars; thereupon she shall  
8 be deemed to be retired and shall receive from the  
9 commonwealth a retirement allowance or pension of  
10                    dollars annually.

The accompanying bill is for the purpose of amending the law relating to the retirement of State employees, and is hereby reported to the Senate by the Senate Committee on Education and Labor.
