To accompany the petition of John W. Coddair, Jr., for legislation to authorize the Department of Conservation to convey to the town of Salisbury a certain parcel of land in said town. Conservation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION TO CONVEY TO THE TOWN OF SALISBURY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of conservation, acting for and in
2 the name and behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby
3 authorized and directed to convey to the town of
4 Salisbury, for use as a parking space, the parcel of
5 land at Salisbury beach in said town, bounded and
6 described as follows, viz.: Northerly, by Beach road;
7 easterly, by Cable avenue; southerly, by land of the
8 town of Salisbury; westerly, by marshland. Said
9 property shall be conveyed by a deed or deeds ap-
10 proved as to form by the attorney general.
