## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO STAY OF JUDGMENT AND EXECUTION  
IN ACTIONS OF SUMMARY PROCESS PERTAINING TO  
CERTAIN FARM EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 43 of the acts of 1946, as  
2 amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the  
3 end the following:— ; provided, however, that a  
4 stay of judgment and execution in the case of premises  
5 occupied by an employee of a farmer conditioned  
6 upon his employment by such farmer and which em-  
7 ployment has been legally terminated, shall not be  
8 granted for a longer period than one month, in the  
9 aggregate,—so as to read as follows:— *Section 1.*  
10 So long as this act continues in force, a stay or suc-  
11 cessive stays of judgment and execution may be  
12 granted under sections nine to thirteen, inclusive, of  
13 chapter two hundred and thirty-nine of the General  
14 Laws, for a period not exceeding twelve months or  
15 for periods not exceeding twelve months in the aggre-

16 gate; provided, however, that a stay of judgment and  
17 execution in the case of premises occupied by an  
18 employee of a farmer conditioned upon his employ-  
19 ment by such farmer and which employment has been  
20 legally terminated, shall not be granted for a longer  
21 period than one month, in the aggregate.
