AN ACT PROVIDING PERMANENT QUARTERS FOR THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 34B of chapter 221 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby
- 3 amended by adding at the end the following sentence:
- 4 — Permanent quarters for the judicial council shall
- 5 be provided in the Suffolk county court house.
