To accompany the petition of John D. Haughey for legislation to authorize the county of Middlesex to pay him a sum of money in compensation for injuries received while working under supervision in the Middlesex house of correction. Counties.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO JOHN HAUGHEY OF NEWTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation, the county of Middlesex is hereby author-
3 ized to pay a sum of money not exceeding fifteen hun-
4 dred dollars to John Haughey of Newton, to compen-
5 sate and reimburse him for medical and hospital ex-
6 penses incurred as a result of an injury received on
7 March eighteenth, nineteen hundred and forty-eight,
8 while working under supervision in the Middlesex
9 house of correction; provided, that the said John
10 Haughey shall submit an itemized list of all unpaid
11 bills, with the names of the persons to whom they are
12 payable, and shall authorize the treasurer of said
13 county to pay to each person the amount of his claim.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the
3 county commissioners of Middlesex county, but not
4 otherwise.
