AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A SECOND ASSISTANT CLERK OF COURT FOR THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF ESSEX AND FOR THE DISTRICT COURT OF CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 10 of chapter 218 of
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by chap-
3 ter 443 of the acts of 1949, is hereby further amended
4 by striking out the third sentence and inserting in
5 place thereof the following sentence:— Second as-
6 sistant clerks with salaries payable by the county may
7 be appointed in the municipal court of the Roxbury
8 district, the East Boston district court, the municipal
9 court of the Charlestown district, the municipal court
10 of the Dorchester district, the municipal court of the
11 Brighton district, the municipal court of the West
12 Roxbury district, the municipal court of the South
13 Boston district, the central district court of Worcester,
14 and, subject to the approval of the county commis-
15 sioners, in the first district court of eastern Middlesex,
16 the third district court of eastern Middlesex, the first
17 district court of Essex, the district court of southern
18 Essex, the district court of Springfield, the second dis-
19 trict court of Bristol, the third district court of Bristol,
20 the district court of East Norfolk and the district
21 court of Chelsea.
