AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF HUDSON TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE PURPOSES OF ACQUIRING LAND AND FOR CONSTRUCTING, EQUIPPING AND ORIGINALLY FURNISHING A NEW HIGH SCHOOL, OR FOR AN ADDITION TO THE PRESENT HIGH SCHOOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purposes of acquiring land  
2 and for the construction of a new high school, or for  
3 an addition to the present high school, and for origi-  
4 nally equipping and furnishing said building or addi-  
5 tion, the town of Hudson may borrow, from time to  
6 time, within a period of five years from the passage  
7 of this act, such sums of money as may be necessary,  
8 not exceeding, in the aggregate, eight hundred thou-  
9 sand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the  
10 town therefor which shall bear on their face the  
11 words, "Hudson School Loan, Act of 1950". Each  
12 authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and

13 such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty  
14 years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under  
15 this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit and  
16 shall, except as provided herein, be subject to chapter  
17 forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the  
18 limitation contained in the first paragraph of section  
19 seven thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
