RESOLUTIONS CONGRATULATING THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM UPON THE TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF ITS ESTABLISHMENT.

1 *Whereas*, The town of Framingham, settled in the
2 fertile valley of the Sudbury river during the early
3 part of the seventeenth century, was established as a
4 town on June twenty-fifth, seventeen hundred; and

5 *Whereas*, The people of Framingham have, from
6 early Colonial times, contributed greatly to the his-
7 torical, agricultural and industrial progress of the
8 commonwealth; now therefore be it

9 *Resolved*, That the General Court extends to the
10 town of Framingham its congratulations upon the
11 two hundred and fiftieth anniversary of its establish-
12 ment as a town; and be it further

13 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be for-
14 warded by the secretary of state to the town clerk of
15 the town of Framingham to be filed with the records
16 in the archives of the town.
