AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO THE CITY OF CHELSEA AS COMPENSATION FOR THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WAYS IN SAID CITY MADE NECESSARY BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MYSTIC RIVER BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There shall be paid to the city of Chel-  
2 sea from the Highway Fund the sum of two hundred  
3 thousand dollars, after appropriation, as compensation  
4 for the cost of construction and reconstruction of  
5 public ways in said city made necessary by the con-  
6 struction of the Mystic River bridge.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
