AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRANSFERS OF EQUIPMENT FROM ONE STATE AGENCY TO ANOTHER BY THE STATE PUR-CHASING AGENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 25A of chapter 7 of the General Laws, in-
- 2 serted by chapter 344 of the acts of 1943, is hereby
- 3 amended by inserting after the word "supplies", in
- 4 line 2, the words: and equipment, so as to read
- 5 as follows: Section 25A. The state purchasing
- 6 agent may provide for the transfer of supplies and
- 7 equipment from one state agency to another when, in
- 8 his opinion, such transfer is for the best interests of
- 9 the commonwealth, and may provide for the making
- 10 of suitable adjustments on the state comptroller's
- 11 books on account of such transfer. He shall also have
- 12 authority to approve the amount or quantities of all
- 13 supplies and materials purchased by state agencies,
- 14 notwithstanding that such agency has conformed to
- 15 the regulations relative to such purchases and that

16 an appropriation is available therefor. In case an 17 application by a state agency is not approved by the 18 state purchasing agent, such agency may appeal in 19 writing to the commission, whose decision shall be 20 final.
