AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE PRESENT INCLINE AND APPROACH TO THE CAMBRIDGE STREET SUBWAY, LOCATED ON CAMBRIDGE STREET BETWEEN JOY STREET AND NORTH RUSSELL STREET, IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan transit authority shall remove
2 the present incline and approach to the Cambridge
3 street subway, located on said Cambridge street, be-
4 tween Joy street and North Russell street, in the city
5 of Boston, constructed under authority of chapter
6 five hundred of the acts of eighteen hundred and
7 ninety-seven, the use of said incline and approach
8 having been discontinued, and shall fill up the ex-
9 cavation of said incline, and, when said incline and
10 approach have been removed and said excavation
11 filled in, shall repave and resurface so much of said
12 Cambridge street between Joy street and North
13 Russell street as may be necessary for traffic purposes,
14 putting such surface in as good condition as the ad-
15 jacent surface of said street.
