AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PROTECTIVE FENCE ALONG BOTH BANKS OF THE MYSTIC RIVER IN ARLINGTON AND MEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct a protective
3 fence along the banks of the Mystic river in the town
4 of Arlington and the city of Medford from Medford
5 street in said town to the Alewife brook in said city.
6 For said purpose, said commission may expend such
7 sums as may hereafter be appropriated therefor.
