AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ERADICATION OF RAGWEED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state department of conservation is hereby
2 authorized and directed to do such things as are con-
3 sidered necessary to suppress, eradicate and destroy
4 ragweed within the commonwealth. For the purpose
5 of carrying out the provisions of this act said depart-
6 ment may expend such sums as may be appropriated
7 therefor.
