AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DUTIES AND SALARIES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF BARBERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by striking out section 41, as amended by section 15  
3 of chapter 591 of the acts of 1946, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following section:—

5 *Section 41.* The members of the board shall  
6 devote their full time to the duties of their offices,  
7 and they shall receive from the commonwealth the  
8 following salaries: the chairman, four thousand five  
9 hundred dollars and his necessary expenses incurred  
10 in the discharge of his official duties, and each of the  
11 other two members, four thousand dollars and his  
12 necessary expense so incurred; provided, that the  
13 salaries and expense of the members of the board shall  
14 not be in excess of the receipts for registration and  
15 from other sources received by the state treasurer  
16 from the board.
