AN ACT TO ESTABLISH STANDARDS OF CERTIFICATION OF TEACHERS IN THE MASSACHUSETTS PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 38G of chapter 71 of the General Laws, in-
2 serted by chapter 278 of the acts of 1951, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the second paragraph and
4 inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 As conditions precedent to the granting of a certifi-
6 cate to an applicant, the board shall require —

7 1. Evidence of American citizenship.

8 2. Evidence of good health.

9 3. Evidence of sound moral character.

10 4. Evidence that the applicant possesses a bachelor's
11 degree approved by the board.
