By Mr. Parenzo of Westfield, petition of Anthony Parenzo that the city of Westfield be authorized to use parking meter receipts for defraying the cost of installing and maintaining traffic control signals in said city. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM PARKING METERS FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS IN THE CITY OF WESTFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Westfield is hereby authorized to use
2 seventy-five per cent of the receipts from parking
3 meters to defray the cost of installation and main-
4 tenance of traffic control signals in the said city;
5 provided, however, that none of such funds shall be
6 used for said purpose until such time as there remains
7 none of the indebtedness incurred for the original cost
8 of acquisition and installation of said parking meters.
