AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LICENSING OF COMMON CARRIERS OF PASSENGERS BY MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 159A of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the
3 following new sentence:— Such license shall provide
4 that no seat shall be located parallel to, even with or
5 in front of the seat provided for the use of the driver
6 of the motor vehicle.
