By Mr. Coltun of Chelsea, petition of Harry Coltun that provision be made for civil service credits to persons serving as auxiliary police or firemen under the civil defense program. Civil Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PERSONS SERVING AS AUXILIARY POLICE OR FIREMEN UNDER THE CIVIL DEFENCE PROGRAM SHALL BE GIVEN CREDIT IN CERTAIN CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding,
2 ing, any member of an auxiliary police or auxiliary
3 fire department under the civil defense program shall
4 receive a credit of five per cent in addition to the
5 work he attains in any civil service examination for
6 appointment to the police or fire department of any
7 city or town in the commonwealth.
