AN ACT EXEMPTING CLERKS OF COURTS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF LAW REQUIRING ENROLLMENT AS A MEMBER OF A POLITICAL PARTY WHOSE NOMINATION HE SEEKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter three hundred and thirty-two of the acts
2 of the year nineteen hundred and fifty-one is hereby
3 amended by striking out in the second paragraph
4 thereof the words "clerks of courts."
