AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
TO RESURFACE AND RELOCATE A PORTION OF WALLUM
POND ROAD IN THE TOWN OF DOUGLAS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The department of public works is hereby directed
2 to relocate and resurface so much of Wallum Pond
3 road in the town of Douglas as lies between Thompson
4 road and the Wallum Pond state reservation. After
5 such relocation and resurfacing has been completed
6 said town of Douglas shall maintain said road as a
7 chapter eighty-one road, so called.
