### AN ACT AUTHORIZING LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITIES TO GRANT CERTAIN YEARLY LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF MALT BEVERAGES AND WINES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter one hun-  
2 dred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the local  
3 licensing authorities of any city or town may grant a  
4 yearly license for the sale of malt beverages and wines  
5 only, not to be drunk on the premises, to any person,  
6 persons, partnership or corporation conducting and  
7 operating a grocery store or market, irrespective of any  
8 limitation of number of licenses as contained in section  
9 seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of  
10 the General Laws. The issuance of such licenses shall  
11 be subject to the payment of a fee not to exceed one  
12 hundred dollars.
