AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEMBERSHIP OF JOHN H. MULLARKEY IN THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any provision of chapter thirty-two of the General
2 Laws to the contrary notwithstanding, John H.
3 Mullarkey, a teacher at the Springfield Trade School,
4 may become a member of the teachers' retirement
5 system upon payment in one sum or in installments,
6 upon such terms and conditions as the teachers'
7 board of retirement may prescribe, of an amount
8 equal to that which would have been withheld as
9 regular deductions from his regular compensation
10 from the date on which he entered the employ of the
11 city of Springfield.
