AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF AN ACT
FOR CERTAIN RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF
SCITUATE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The provisions of chapter eight hundred and twenty
2 of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty for the
3 town of Scituate shall become effective on January
4 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-one, this act having
5 been accepted by the voters at a special town meeting
6 held on October fifteenth, nineteen hundred and
7 fifty-one.
