AN ACT RELATIVE TO FEES CHARGED FOR CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRATION OF BARBERS AND BARBER SHOPS AND FOR THE INSPECTION OF BARBER SHOPS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 87H of
2 chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in
3 section 1 of chapter 314 of the acts of 1936, is hereby
4 amended by striking out, in line 4, the word "ten"
5 and inserting in place thereof the word: — twenty.

1 SECTION 2. The second paragraph of said section
2 87H of said chapter 112, as appearing in chapter 319
3 of the acts of 1950, is hereby amended by striking
4 out, in line 25, the word "ten" and inserting in place
5 thereof the word: — fifteen, — and by striking out,
6 in line 33, the word "two" and inserting in place
7 thereof the word: — five.
