### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE REGISTRATION OF BARBERS AND THE PRACTICE OF BARBERING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 87I of chapter 112 of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws, as amended by section 2 of chapter 579 of  
3 the acts of 1948, is hereby further amended by strik-  
4 ing out, in line 21, the words "six months, including  
5 at least one thousand" and inserting in place thereof  
6 the words: — nine months, including at least fifteen  
7 hundred, — so that the third sentence will read as  
8 follows: — Any such student, after having completed  
9 a course of at least nine months, including at least  
10 fifteen hundred hours consisting of not more than  
11 eight hours in any one day, of training in barbering  
12 in such a barber school or barber college, may apply  
13 for an examination, or for a second or subsequent ex-  
14 amination, if he has failed to pass an earlier exami-  
15 nation.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 87I of said chapter 112,  
2 as so amended, is hereby further amended by striking  
3 out, in line 32, the word "six" and inserting in place  
4 thereof the word:— nine, — and by striking out, in  
5 line 35, the word "eighteen" and inserting in place  
6 thereof the word:— fifteen, — so that the fifth sen-  
7 tence will read as follows:— After having practiced for  
8 two years, nine months thereof in a barber school or  
9 barber college, approved by the board, under the in-  
10 struction of an instructor and fifteen months thereof  
11 under a registered barber, and upon the payment of the  
12 required fee for examination, such apprentice shall be  
13 eligible for examination by the board for registration  
14 as a barber.
