AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AND ENABLE THE INHABITANTS OF WATERTOWN TO SELL, DISPOSE OF, TRANSFER AND CONVEY TITLE TO THE TOWN INFIRMARY AND THE WHOLE OR ANY PORTION OF LAND ADJACENT THERETO USED BY THE TOWN HERETOFORE IN CONNECTION WITH SAID INFIRMARY OR AS A POOR FARM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The inhabitants of Watertown are  
2 hereby authorized and enabled to sell, dispose of,  
3 transfer and convey title to the town infirmary, and  
4 the whole or any portion of land adjacent thereto,  
5 bounded in part by George street, Lowell avenue,  
6 Bailey avenue and Wilson avenue, used by the town  
7 heretofore in connection with said infirmary, or as a  
8 poor farm, and also to lay out, construct and maintain  
9 streets or public ways over any portion of said land  
10 and to construct, install, lay and maintain sewers,  
11 drains, storm water drains and water mains in any  
12 streets or public ways thereon.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon accept-  
2 ance thereof by the town by a vote of a majority of the  
3 members present at an annual or special town meeting  
4 called for that purpose.
