AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROMOTION OF CERTAIN PERSONS IN THE CIVIL SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 in section 15, paragraph A, by inserting after the
3 second to the last sentence the following new sen-
4 tence: — If, however, a request is made for the pro-
5 motion, in the same department or division of a de-
6 partment, of an employee (in the official service) in
7 one grade to the next higher grade as determined by
8 the director, who has been a permanent employee in
9 said department or division of a department for at
10 least twenty years and who has passed an examination
11 for the position for which such promotion is requested,
12 the director of civil service may, on the request of the
13 appointing officer made within five years of the date
14 of the examination, authorize such promotion with-
15 out further examination.
