*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 The commissioner of conservation, on behalf of  
2 the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to acquire  
3 by purchase or otherwise the wharf, lands, buildings  
4 and contents thereof, comprising the fish freezing  
5 plant of the Harbor View Marine Corporation, a  
6 Massachusetts corporation, located in the town of  
7 Fairhaven, and, upon the acquisition of said property  
8 as aforesaid, said fish freezing plant shall be main-  
9 tained and operated by the department of conserva-  
10 tion. For the purposes of this act, said department  
11 may expend such sums as may be appropriated  
12 therefor.
