AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE KILLING OF UNLICENSED DOGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 151A of chapter 140 of the General Laws,
2 as amended, is hereby further amended by striking
3 out, in lines 10 and 11, as appearing in section 2 of
4 chapter 11 of the acts of 1948, the words "six days"
5 and inserting in place thereof the words: — seven days
6 after notice of finding of such dog, describing the same,
7 has been published in a newspaper, if any, published
8 in the town where the dog was found, otherwise in a
9 newspaper published in the county where the dog was
10 found, — and by striking out, in line 12, as so appear-
11 ing, the word "six" and inserting in place thereof the
12 word: — seven.
