AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GIVING OF SIGNALS BY OPERATORS OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 14B, inserted by chapter 649
3 of the acts of 1951, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following: —

5 *Section 14B.* Every motor vehicle shall be equipped
6 with stop lights which shall operate automatically
7 when the operator of such motor vehicle applies the
8 foot brake.
