AN ACT AMENDING THE TRANSFER OR OWNERSHIP OF A REGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLE OR TRAILER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is
2 amended by inserting in the first sentence of the fifth
3 paragraph after the words "A person who transfers
4 the ownership of a registered motor vehicle or trailer
5 owned by him to another or loses possession thereof"
6 the following clause:— may, subject to all other
7 provisions of this chapter, operate a newly acquired
8 motor vehicle or trailer for a period beginning from
9 the date of transfer until five o'clock post meridian
10 of the second registry business day following the date
11 of transfer; provided, the number plates issued to
12 register the transferred motor vehicle or trailer are
