AN ACT REGULATING THE FARES OF STUDENTS DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
2 trary, the rates of fare charged by the Metropolitan
3 Transit Authority for the transportation of school
4 pupils during the period schools are in session shall
5 not exceed one half of the regular fare charged by
6 such Metropolitan Transit Authority for the trans-
7 portation of other passengers between said points.
