AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT IN PART OF LOSSES IN TAXES ON PROPERTY TO THE TOWN OF LENOX BY REASON OF ITS USE FOR CHARITABLE, EDUCATIONAL, SCIENTIFIC OR RELIGIOUS PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

3 the last taxes assessed and payable in said town upon
4 such parcels therein now exempt from taxation by
5 reason of their use for charitable, educational, scien-
6 tific or religious purposes.
