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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

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### AN ACT TO REQUIRE INSURERS UNDER THE COMPULSORY MOTOR VEHICLE LAW TO FURNISH COPIES OF REPORTS OF MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Any insurer under the compulsory motor vehicle  
2 law, who requests a medical examination of an in-  
3 jured person involved in an automobile accident, shall  
4 furnish upon request of the injured person or of his  
5 attorney, copies of all medical examinations made  
6 by said insurer.
