AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A FOOTBRIDGE OVER MEMORIAL DRIVE IN CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby
- 2 authorized and directed to construct a footbridge or
- 3 ramp over Memorial drive, at Magazine street, in the
- 4 city of Cambridge.

The House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Session assembled, do hereby pass the following resolution:

The Constitution of 1870
