AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPROPRIATING POWER OF THE
SCHOOL COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 224 of the acts of 1936, as most recently
2 amended, is hereby further amended by striking out
3 section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 2.* The school committee of the city of
6 Boston may, by vote of four fifths of all its members,
7 taken by yeas and nays, make appropriations to be
8 raised by taxation.
