The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID FOR OVERTIME WORK OR SERVICES BY EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any provision of general or special laws to the con-
2 trary, all service rendered by an employee of the
3 commonwealth at the request of the appointing offi-
4 cer in excess of eight hours in any one day, and all
5 service rendered by an employee of the common-
6 wealth at the request of the appointing officer in ex-
7 cess of forty hours in any one week shall be com-
8 pensated at time and one half the regular rate of
9 compensation.
